PRIVATE PILOT COURSE

The FAA approved Part 141 Private Pilot Course requires a minimum of 35 hours flight time. Our Part 141 ground school is 100% online and access to the course is available for 1 year.

COMMERCIAL PILOT COURSE

After successfully completing the Private Pilot Course, pilots may move on to an instrument rating and Commercial Pilot License. Both are required for employment as a pilot.

INSTRUMENT RATING

The FAA Instrument Rating course requires 35 hours minimum of dual instruction. Ground school is conducted in conjunction with the flight course.

FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Pilots who want to become a flight instructor can receive training to get the Certified Flight Instructor rating.

MILITARY COMPETENCY

Military pilots can obtain their commercial and instrument or instructor ratings by successfully completing and passing the military competency exams.

Air Force COOL, Army IgnitED, Navy COOL, and Marine Corps COOL

Check with your Education office about available benefits. Credentialing assistance can be used for private pilot or the A&P course.
